

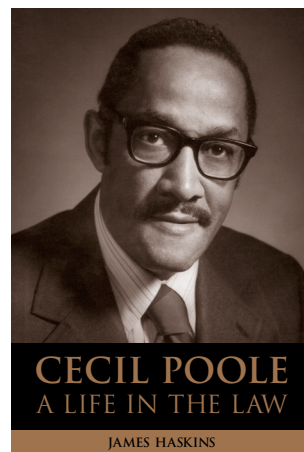
THE JUDGE CECIL POOLE BIOGRAPHY PROJECT
